That is how all O Gauge trains were until the mid-1990s when command control technology became available.

Command mode is quite different. In a command environment, like MTH's DCS system, you control each train, switch, and accessory independently by communicating directly with it. You set the track voltage high, to ensure that the trains get enough power, then leave it alone. The remote control communicates with whichever engine or accessory you want to control and sends it a message telling it what to do. 





# O-6-O USRA Steam Switcher

Switch engines are an essential, specialized piece of railroad equipment that look quite different from their kin that work the mainline. Because of the nature of their work, moving cars around railroad yards, switch engines spent much of their time waiting for their assignments. That means steam switchers needed smaller fireboxes, boilers, and tanks than road engines. The cut out or sloping tanks on most steam switchers were designed to give good rear visibility, which was essential for these small and agile engines that needed to slip into tight spaces where other engines could not fit. The 0-6-0 switcher would typically have been assigned to move about six cars at a time.

The rugged RailKing 0-6-0, available in a host of roadnames, is perfect for working the yard of any early twentieth-century layout.



# 4-6-0 Camelback Steam Engines

Railroads that served the mines of eastern Pennsylvania had a cheap and abundant supply of anthracite coal. However, the traditional deep fireboxes of most steam locomotives were not suited to burning anthracite coal, which required a shallow box to reach high temperatures. The Camelback steamer was designed to allow eastern railroads efficient use of this fuel. It boasted a wider, shallower firebox that allowed coal to burn hot. However, this firebox displaced the cab, which had to be moved to the middle of the engine, straddling the boiler. While the engineer worked from this cramped cab, the fireman remained at the rear of a locomotive on an often unprotected deck.

Working conditions on a Camelback (so named because of the odd bulge of the center cab) were difficult at best. The engineer and fireman could communicate only with great difficulty, the small cab had little room for the controls, and the fireman had to do his difficult task of feeding an extra wide firebox with even less protection than traditional engines afforded.

# **Steam Engine**The 4-6-0 Steam Locomotive

4-6-0 Ten Wheeler

The 4-6-0 Steam Locomotive appeared on the railroad scene in the middle of the 19th Century. It largely replaced the popular 4-4-0 when more powerful engines were needed to serve areas of the Rocky Mountains on through to the western coast of the United States.

The 4-4-0 design was modified by Richard Norris & Son of Philadelphia, who added an extra coupled axle at the rear of the locomotive to make it the 4-6-0, or as it is commonly known -- "a 10-wheeler." This permitted the construction of a bigger boiler, which along with the extra wheel drivers, produced a 50% stronger adhesion to climb the steep inclines of the Rocky Mountains.

The 4-6-0 Steam Engine was used by the Denver Rio Grande (DRG) Railroad to serve the abundant timber, coal, silver and gold regions of the Colorado Mountains. 



# 4-6-2 Pacific Steam Engines





# 4-8-4 GS-4 Northern Steam Engine

In the 1920s, Southern Pacific rethought the standard approach to motive power; rather than changing engines at division points, they wanted to develop an engine for use on extended runs. Their famous 4-8-4 GS-series of locomotives resulted. 4-8-4 Northerns originated with the Northern Pacific railroad in 1926 and quickly became popular on other roads. The eight drivers allowed the engines to generate more power than engines with fewer driving wheels, and the four trailing wheels supported a larger firebox, increasing boiler capacity. This combination allowed 4-8-4s to best even larger 2-10-2-types by sustaining higher speeds over longer distances.

# 4-8-4 "J" Northern Steam Engine

While many railroads had switched to diesel power by the 1950's, Norfolk and Western was profitably using steam power until the 1960's. No other railroad fought dieselization for so long. The locomotive that led the fight was the "J" class 4-8-4. The J was so successful because in its design, N&W addressed one of the main problems that railroads had with steam locomotives: maintenance. The J's axleboxes had roller bearings. Its mechanical lubricators oiled other bearings, the steam cylinders and oil pumps. With these and other advancements, J's only had to visit the repair shops once every 1 ½ years.

Even though N&W built their J's in their own Roanoke, Virginia shops, outside sources supplied many necessary parts. Many of these outside suppliers were rapidly going out of business. The parts supply shortages, a changing coal market, changing horsepower needs and other factors finally caused the end of the last steam program in 1960.

Today, the Norfolk and Western J is alive and well and returns to the RailKing line of steam engines with the incredible Proto-Sound 2.0 digital command system.






# **GP-7** Diesel Engines








# **SD-45** Diesel Engines



Because of the addition of the dual generator, AC-powered fans and blowers could be operated electrically, boosting the locomotives' ability to stay in top form. The 1,500-h.p. rated F-3, with its bulldog nose and dual capabilities set a standard in railroading. In test runs, No. 291, a demonstrator unit, logged over 125,000 miles in sixteen months pulling freight and passenger loads. Railroads were impressed with the tests and hundreds of advanced orders for the F-3s poured in.





# GG-1 Electric Engines

The GG-1 could be called the Gold Standard for electric locomotives, with its unparalleled longevity and road performance. The GG-1 survived longer than any other locomotive design, lasting well into the 1980s, and survived both the railroad that created it and that road's successor, Penn Central.

In the 1920s, the great rise in the popularity of the automobile prompted a desperate effort to save the dying streetcar industry. ## 4-8-4 Unshrouded J Steam Locomotive

Although the N&W Class J steamers are best known for their streamlined, cowled appearance, the railroad built five uncowled 4-8-4s without lightweight rods, classed J1, in 1943 to conserve war materials. Although the N&W surely knew that the Js would ultimately be used for passenger service, the restrictions of the War Production Board required that they be classified as freight engines and given an appropriately lower boiler pressure than the other Js had. Even without its characteristic sleek appearance, the unstreamlined Js were able to muscle their loads over the mountainous N&W territory, serving admirably for their part in the war effort. These five engines were later given cowls and the usual Class J siderods.



## FEF 4-8-4 Northern Steam Engine

One of the most celebrated locomotive series in railroading history, Union Pacific's Mighty "800's" established new standards for performance upon their debut in the 1930s. Initially used for heavy passenger work, the 800s later moved to fast-freight service, proving themselves as outstanding examples of design and wheel configuration use. One of the early FEFs (UP shorthand for "four-eight-four") stood up to a 1938 national speed test, hitting the 102 mph mark with a 1,000 ton load, outstripping the competition put up by Pennsylvania and Chicago NorthWestern.

In 1962, the UP's #844 (the last of the series) was reconditioned and renumbered 8444. Currently, the 8444, which was never retired from service, has regained its original 844 number and now sports an all-black paint scheme. A featured engine at Railfair<sup>TM</sup> '99 in Sacramento, she remains an active national treasure for all railroading fans to enjoy, frequently providing motive power for railfan excursions.

At 309,000 pounds, the H-9 developed 71,500 pounds of tractive effort, more than sufficient to pull a 100 load train of 7,800 tons. The Western Maryland ultimately obtained 50 of these coal-hauling powerhouses.





## 2-8-8-8-2 Triplex Steam Engine

In 1914 the Erie Railroad accepted delivery of a gigantic Baldwin-built 2-8-8-8-2 Triplex steamer. The P1-class tipped the scales at 853,050 pounds, and the third set of eight drivers, placed under the tender, meant that 89 percent of that weight was available for adhesion. When the Erie saw plans for the Triplex, they thought it represented the perfect solution to their primary operating problem: hauling heavy freight over Susquehanna Hill, a route where a short, steep grade significantly reduced the capacity of most road steamers. The Triplex eliminated the need for additional pushers to help a load top the hill. The engine's articulation also meant that of the total driving wheelbase of 71' 6", only 16' 6" was rigid - ideal for the winding track over Susquehanna Hill. Best of all, because it distributed its weight over such a large number of wheels, it combined high tractive effort with moderate axle loads, which meant it ran well on reasonably light track. It was so successful on the Erie's tricky Susquehanna route that the railroad ordered two more Triplexes in 1916. The difficulty of maintaining full steam pressure combined with the cost of maintenance on what was essentially three engines in one led to the Triplex's retirement in 1927.

This extraordinary O Gauge die-cast locomotive returns to the MTH lineup in 2003 in Virginian livery. The Virginian Railroad actually utilized a 2-8-8-8-4 version of the Triplex, however this beautifully detailed Premier model can still be the king of any working freight line.

### 4-Truck Shay Steam Engine

In the early 1900's the mountains in and around West Virginia were crawling with lumber crews foresting the best spruce nature had to offer. As the lumber was harvested, track crews - keeping just ahead of the lumberjacks - worked even harder to reach deeper into the forest.

She fearlessly tackled the Spruce covered mountain grades for the next 20 years before retiring in 1943 and being unceremoniously scraped in 1955.

In 2003 we've redecorated No. 12 with the livery of the Elk River Coal & Lumber Company as well as the Chesapeake & Ohio railroad.

Completely constructed from all die-cast metal components, this 22 inch long powerhouse features the same all-wheel powered drive train that made Shays so powerful in the first place. In fact, you'll be hard pressed to find any grade that will be too steep for this tireless worker.

### 6-4-4-6 S1 Steam Engine

The Pennsylvania Railroads final steam locomotive development years were dominated by flashy, eve-catching streamlined designs of unconventional wheel arrangements. Pennsy fans were often taken aback with the railroad's decision to abandon its deep seated affection for conventionalism.

Indeed, the S1 was capable of hauling 1,200 tons at over 100 miles per hour.

## M10000 Diesel Passenger Set

Among the earliest of the 1930's stream-liners, the Union Pacific M-10000's sleek good looks attracted huge crowds - including an inspection by President Roosevelt - on its inaugural nationwide tour when it premiered in 1934. The 204 ft. long, three-car train was so well recognized and so distinctive in appearance that many passengers in the UP's territory referred to it simply as "The Streamliner," as though it were the final word on the design. ## 2500 HP Transfer Diesel Engines

In 1950-1951, Lima-Hamilton built twenty-two colossal 2,500-hp transfer units for the Pennsylvania Railroad. These boxy center-cab units served for transfer work, which was similar to switching but on a larger scale. Rather than simply moving cars around a yard, these more powerful diesel engines moved cars from one yard to another, covering longer distances and heavier consists that would have been too challenging for many switchers. Although this large, dualengine unit worked well for the PRR and its need to move coal cars from the mines to a central yard, such a large transfer unit proved too bulky and inflexible for many railroads, which opted for a cowand-calf arrangement when they needed to perform heavier switching duties.

## **GP-40 Diesel Engines**

By the mid-'60s, EMD's General Purpose locomotives, known as "Geeps," had gained a favorable reputation with railroads. They were hard working road switchers known for their versatility and dependability. The 1500-h.p. GP-7, introduced in 1949, had set the standard for the series of locomotives, and the GP-40, which came along 16 years later, was to be yet another improvement in the GP family tree.

The GP-40 doubled the horsepower rating of the GP-7 and introduced the 645-series engine to the Geep heritage. EMD had relied upon the 567series prime mover for years. The 3,000-h.p. in the GP-40 was indeed impressive, but it presented a problem. With only four axles and the barely adequate wheel-slip control systems then available, GP-40s had adhesion problems. While the units were being fixed at the La Grange, IL, plant, EMD supplied GP-40 buyers with temporary units. An improved electrical system fixed the adhesion problem on the GP-40s and they were ready to roll on U.S., Canadian and Mexican railroads once again.

Each model is available in three cab numbers and can be paired with a separately sold non-powered unit in a fourth cab number.


### DD40AX Diesel **Engines**



# DL-109 Diesel Engines and DL-110 Powered B Unit Diesel Engines

The Otto Kuhler-designed DL-109 engines were ALCO's initial response to EMD's success with the streamlined Eseries of road passenger locomotives. With its long, turned-up nose and smooth sides, the DL-109 helped to popularize the colorful paint schemes of the midtwentieth century. The DL-109s were, like the E-Series, twin-engine 2000 horsepower units designed to be run in combination, with railroads piling on as many engines as it took to do the task at hand. ALCO also built matching B-units, dubbed DL-110s, for railroads interested in adding a cabless unit to the lash-up. Introduced in 1941, the DL-109 was produced under the auspices of the War Production Board during World War II, when the production of other passenger diesels had been prohibited. At the end of the war, ALCO ceased to build the DL-109, shifting its efforts instead to the PA.

Now your railroad can benefit from this engine, which was sanctioned by the War Production Board and can bring additional legitimacy to any World War II-era layout. It is available in the markings of Chicago NorthWestern, New Haven and Southern railroads.



#### F-3 ABA Diesel Sets

World War II had called for locomotive manufacturers to adhere to production guidelines as set by the War Production Board. With the war's end in 1945, EMD, like other major competitors, worked hard to meet industry demand after four years of restricted supply. In the freight cab market, EMD released their F-series. The F-3 headlined the series, debuting in the summer of 1945, a few months before the official end of the war.

The F-3 emerged with a new generator that supplied both direct and alternating current, an important upgrade for EMD's initial F-unit design. Because of the addition of the dual generator, AC-powered fans and blowers could be operated electrically, boosting the locomotives' ability to stay in top form. The 1,500-h.p. rated F-3, with its bulldog nose and dual capabilities set a standard in railroading. In test runs, No. 291, a demonstrator unit, logged over 125,000 miles in sixteen months pulling freight and passenger loads. Railroads were impressed with the tests and hundreds of advanced orders for the F-3s poured in.

EMD and Premier fans will no doubt want to order this stellar replica of the F-3 dressed in either Canadian National, Frisco or Missouri Pacific livery. The Premier F-3 represents the bulldog tenacity of the prototype in 1:48 scale complete with the awesome sounds and features of Proto-Sound 2.0.

# FT ABA Diesel Sets

The EMD-built FT was born in November 1939, in the La Grange, IL, General Motors plant. The FT demonstrator, 103, didn't take any baby steps. It came out bold and sure of itself and with its efficient design, spelled the end of steam's reign. That same month of production, the demonstrator started out on an 11-month 35-state tour. The 103 logged 83,764 miles, working on 20 Class I railroads in below freezing as well as sweltering conditions, pulling anything and everything.

The FT demonstrator was made up of four units, each equipped with a 16-cylinder engine that hammered out 1350 units of horsepower. The units were either designated as "A," which were 48'3" long or "B," a 48'1" booster. The set was capable of delivering a combined horsepower rating of 5400. # SD60M Diesel Engines

The first order of General Motor's SD60M diesel locomotive were slated for the Union Pacific Railroad and began delivering in January 1989. The 25-unit order featured GM's version of the North American Safety Cab and represented the 7th and latest order for EMD's high-horsepower, six-axle locomotive.

The Safety Cab had undergone several changes in appearance with the transition from a three-piece windshield to a two-piece model one of the most obvious. Other changes include front number boards above the windshield and a window glass in the nose's front cab access door.

The SD60M returns to the MTH line-up in 2003 in five paint schemes including a specially decorated Burlington Northern version from their 1991 tribute to America's Desert Storm troops. The patriotically decorated cab was designed by an electrician in BN's Springfield, Missouri shops and includes the Great Seal Of The United States on the cab's nose and 26 stars throughout the body cladding. Another 24 stars decorate the chassis for a total of 50 stars - one for each state in the Union.

### No. 200 Wood Gondola

The No. 200 Wood Gondola, first cataloged in 1901, is perhaps the rarest of toy train collectibles. Less than 10 of the two model types are known to exist today.

The gondola was produced in both motorized and non-motorized versions. Two types were designed, Type I was approximately 15 inches in length, while Type II - which debuted in 1902 - measured out at 17 1/2 inches in length. Neither type was ever cataloged again and many myths exist regarding the gondola including its finish and lettering style which have helped add to its legend as a rare collectible.

Now, for the first time in more than a century, the No. 200 Wood Gondola will return to the rails as part of the 2003 Tinplate Traditions lineup. 

### Race Car Set

Even model train manufacturers recognized that not all travelers exclusively relied on the railroad to get them to their destination. Consequently, several "transportation toys" debuted early in the history of model railroading and were marketed to tinplate model railroaders as accessories for their layouts. Two of these are featured in our 2003 Tinplate Traditions lineup, the No. 85 Race Car Set and the No. 50 Airplane and Airport set.

The 1912 No. 85 Race Car Set was the forerunner of the slot car era of the 1960s. Two tinplate constructed cars, featuring rubber tires and cast driver and passenger rode atop a tinplate track section in the shape of a two lane oval. Powered by a standard AC transformer, the cars would zip around the track with pickups sparking the motors whining.

The No. 85 returns to life again in 2003 and can be expanded with additional straight and curve sections of track. This very limited production run is a must for any tinplate enthusiast looking to recreate the full range of tinplate products offered for the early model train enthusiast.
