


Tinplate Traditions by M.T.H.

M.T.H. founder Mike Wolf's life was impacted by his first memories of the shiny tinplate locomotives of his grandfather's youth. Those memories have made his Tinplate Tradition's line a personal favorite; he appreciates the artistry found in the colors and shapes of these unusual engines and cars.

Tinplate trains are made of stamped or diecast metal, generally boasting bright, colorful enamel paint, and they are not meant to be accurate reproductions of real trains. Standard and O Gauge tinplate trains, like those in the M.T.H.

No. 1134 DORFAN STEAMER



This sleek steamer defines the quiet elegance of the Tinplate Traditions line. The Ives #1134 is one of the largest Standard Gauge steam locomotives ever. The 1134 was patterned after the Baltimore & Ohio's 4-4-0 President Washington, but the wheel designation chosen on the model was 4-4-2.

The styling of the engine captured the very essence of American steam engines, but the lack of purity in the castings of the Ives steamers threatened the lifespan of the beautifully crafted locomotive. With its stamped steel body, baked enamel finish and metal wheels and axles, durability is not a problem for this M.T.H. model.



By the late 1920s, America's deepening financial crisis was driving model train manufacturers out of business or crippling those still clinging to life. One of those on life support was the Ives Corporation whose continuing sales were buoyed by the production of beautiful, well constructed and engineered trains that stood up favorably to market leader Joshua Lionel Cowen.



Yet Ives always seemed to be a step behind Cowen and often followed his lead on product direction and changes. One exception was the decision to invest much of the remaining company profits into the development of two electric type locomotives; a small economy box model and a larger S-type cab based loosely on a New York Central prototype. It was this latter model which led to the 3245 Electric of which two versions were created. These very scarce models used the same number and were described as short hood or long hood models depending on the version. As the

moniker hinted, the difference was the length of the front and rear hoods.

M.T.H. is proud to release the Ives #3245 in 2004 complete with all the sounds and action of Proto-Sound 2.0. Imagine the looks on visitor faces when they see and hear this beautiful locomotive creeping along your pike while playing incredibly realistic sound effects. In fact, its those sounds that will give away the fact this locomotive is a reproduction, as we've captured the looks and details of the original right down to every rivet detail and window location.

During model railroading's early history, standard gauge timplate locomotives ruled the day. Immensely appealing for all their color and flash, these giant locomotives consumed vast amounts of real estate in their owner's homes. The call went out to pre-war model railroad manufacturers for smaller model trains. Soon thereafter, O Gauge model railroading was born.

First appearing in 1936, the tinplate 263E steam locomotive replaced the O Gauge 260 engine and was decorated in two colors; blue or

gray. The blue versions headed up the Tinplate O Gauge Blue Comet passenger cars while the gray version originally headed two versions of 800 series freight sets.

Today, the 263E returns to M.T.H.'s Tinplate Traditions lineup for the first time since 1998. But now, just beneath the graceful lines of the tinplate boiler, lies the excitement of Proto-Sound 2.0 whose revolutionary electronics control a smooth-running chassis capable of running at just a few scale miles per hour. Cracking open the throttle

and bringing the locomotive forward releases the first blasts of smoke from the engine's stack enhanced with the realistic sounds of chuffing. As the engine picks up speed one notices that each huge puff of smoke is timed to the driver's revolutions. The wail of the whistle and the clang of the bell further stimulate the senses until the realization that the flash and color of yesteryear is but a faded memory when compared to a Proto-Sound 2.0 equipped Tinplate Traditions locomotive.

The largest and perhaps flashiest of Joshua Lionel Cowen's standard gauge electric locomotives wasn't the company's most expensive. That distinction belonged to the 2-motored 408E. But it was the 381E, based loosely on a 4-4-4 wheel arrangement, that has earned the distinction of being one of the most prized possessions that a pre-war tinplate era collector can own.

In fact, given the limited capabilities in the 1920s to faithfully recreate an accurate model of a real life prototype, the 381E did a fairly good job of impersonating a Milwaukee Road electric that ran over the mountainous stretches between Othello and Tacoma, Washington.

Fortunately, the M.T.H. version of the 381E does an excellent job of recreating the look and colors of the pre-war timplate original. Aside

from the stampings and plates identifying the engine as an M.T.H. model, a user would be hard pressed to tell the difference. Until, that is, one runs a Contemporary version equipped with Proto-Sound 2.0. No original 381E could ever run as smoothly or slowly and nor recreate the sounds of a real locomotive like the M.T.H. version.



MAYFLOWER STANDARD GAUGE PRESIDENTIAL LOCOMOTIVE



One of the most stunning Standard Gauge locomotive sets to ever grace a pike first appeared in 1927 from American Flyer®. Featuring a twelve-wheel electric locomotive and four matching passenger cars, the original Mayflower set was based on the President's Special set first cataloged in 1926. Unlike the President's Set from the year before, the Mayflower was produced with an

all-chrome finish that added to the already rich detail and design of the engine and cars.

This extremely limited version of the Mayflower has been included in M.T.H.'s 2004 Tinplate Tradition's lineup with a contemporary version that provides stellar performance to go along with its great looks. As with the original, the set features an 19 1/2 inch long locomotive

modeled after the New York Central's P2 Box Cab Electric and features a big American Eagle on its front porch. The four matching passenger cars, each measuring 21 inches long, utilize a total of 12 interior lamps and feature brightly polished plating on their six-wheel trucks.

IVES PROSPERITY SET - CONTEMPORARY



Ready for delivery in the summer of 1929, Ives was unable to forecast the devastation set to wreak havoc on the U.S. economy as a result of the September "Black Friday" stock market crash. The resulting pressure from his creditors forced Harry Ives from the company and made this \$100.00 train set a timeless collector piece.

Originally produced in a copper and nickel finish, the #1134 locomotive and 3-car passenger set has been recreated in stunning detail. Outfitted with the incredible sounds and features of Proto-Sound 2.0, the Prosperity Set is sure to reward those who have never had an opportunity to even see a surviving original with a new, but limited chance of ownership.





The 0-4-0 No. 10 (with its e-unit reversing counterpart No. 10E) was the second smallest electric engine made in the heyday of tinplate.
