

Operating No. 787 Log Loader

The No. 787 Operating Log Loader adds exciting action to your logging railroad. When in operation, the Log Loader scoops up one log at a time from the platform base, the carriage and hook rise, and the log is dropped into a car waiting below.

It is easy to operate the Log Loader when you follow the operating instructions.

Wiring the Log Loader:

After positioning and mounting the log loader onto your layout (use the screw holes in the corner of the base):

Note: The log loader needs 14v to operate properly.



Connect red/black paired wires from the activation button to the red and black transformer outputs.



Connect black/black paired wires to the thumbscrews; it doesn't matter which wire goes to which thumbscrew

Set Up:

Place the logs on the base, centered so that the black log lifter can raise them one at a time for the hook.



Operation:

Press and hold the button to operate the log loader. Once you release the button, the accessory will stop operating.
